A total of up to \$10,000 in grant funding will be awarded across selected organizations this cycle. While we aim to equitably support communities across all five regions where HTB operates, final award amounts will be determined based on the strength, feasibility, and impact of applications received. HTB reserves the right to determine the number and size of awards after reviewing all submissions.

Grant recipients will be notified following the close of the application review process, and funds will be distributed by the end of the calendar year. Selected organizations will receive further details regarding award amounts, reporting expectations, and opportunities to share their impact stories as part of HTB's ongoing community engagement efforts.
